### **NOTEBOOKS**

6 spiral bound notebooks with 80 pages (or more) each

### **FOLDERS/DIVIDERS**

1-3 Accordion folders with places to label each pocket

1 Pack of index cards (3 X 5 inches or 8 X 13 cm.)

### **WRITING IMPLEMENTS**

Pencil case

Black, blue, green & red pens

1 box of pencils

1 Set of colored pencils (can use colored pencils for Art class)

Highlighters (three different colors)

Erasers, 3 Glue Sticks

Pencil sharpener (with container for shavings)

### **SPECIAL SUPPLIES**

Small ruler that can fit into a pencil case

Geometry set (includes protractor and compass)

Scissors

1 roll Scotch tape

Pen drive (512mb or larger)

### **CALCULATORS**

**Pre-Algebra** students should have a scientific calculator

**Algebra** students should have a graphing calculator\*

(TI 84+ suggested, but 83 or 84 will suffice)

**Please have all materials clearly marked with the student's name.**

### **A NOTE ON CALCULATORS**

\*\*While the graphing calculator is only recommended (highly), students will understand the math course so much better with it. In addition, when they get to high school, a graphing calculator will be mandatory for Math, Science and Business courses.

\*\*It is expensive but will be an investment that will carry them through high school and University

**\*\*Graphing calculators tend to be significantly less expensive in the United States. You may want to consider this if you are travelling during the break.**
