DAY 1/ SCHOOL / POCHOCO HILL

Meeting at school in the morning, we will go to the **Pochoco Hill** that is in the Arrayan sector, this hill is in the pre mountain range of the central area and one of **the best known within those that begin in trekking techniques and mountaineering**. We will arrive at the summit to **cook our own lunch**, we will learn to use kitchens and camping pots to arrive prepared for our last challenge of the week. Back to school in the afternoon.



DAY 2 *SCHOOL / CHALLENGE CENTER*

Day 3/ *SCHOOL / LO VALDES*

Meeting at the school in the morning, we will leave for the Cajón del Maipo to the Lo Valdes sector, where we will begin our acclimatization, knowing the surroundings of the place, doing activities such as rappelling, backpack assembly workshops, do not leave a trail (NDR) and camp. Then start preparing the next day's expedition. Dinner and accommodation in German Refuge.



DAY 4 – 5 / *LO VALDES*

After a refreshing breakfast we will prepare to leave for El Morado National Park, where we will set up our base camp, where we will rest and have dinner. The next day we will get up very early to reach our final goal, El Morado Glacier, and then disassemble our tents again. Have lunch and return to Santiago.
