# WINTER CAMP 2022 POLICIES

### PAYMENT POLICY

- Winter Camp will use *First Come, First Served based Signups*, where students will be able to sign up for one activity a day for the entire week (5 days) if spots are still available.
- Students will only be allowed to change activity **before the second day of the program begins** (and only if there are available spots).
- Parents/students who join Winter Camp late will need to pay full price for the program.
- Refund Policy:
  - 50% refund in case of cancellation before June 20th, 2022.
  - 25% refund in case of cancellation before July 1st, 2022.
  - No refunds will be issued after July 1st, 2022.
  - Students who are injured or ill and cannot attend the camp may receive up to a 50% refund or a proportional amount based on the number of days remaining, whichever is less, upon presentation of a valid medical certificate.

# HEALTH & SAFETY (COVID 19)

- Parents must establish a daily inspection routine **of their children** before sending them to school (monitoring for temperatures of 37.5 C and above and checking for respiratory symptoms). They will alert the Health Unit and not send their children to school when at least one of the symptoms is present in their child.
- Masks will be required indoors at all times. Please ensure you pack extra masks daily.
- Parents will make sure your child has the proper equipment required to participate safely for each activity.

## **BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS**

Nido strives to support each student, and all members of the community, by creating an environment where all are welcomed and valued. The co-curricular program is an extension of learning and provides an enriching, impactful experience for students. Participation in the Winter Camp program is a privilege, and the same high expectations for behavior, respect for others, and good citizenship that exist within the Nido school day apply to the external programs.

For most types of discipline issues, our policy includes two warning levels, after which the child will be removed from the Winter Camp Program. For severe behavioral offenses (e.g. fighting, bullying, harassment, etc.), the camp directors reserve the right to remove a child from camp immediately and with no refund.

• First Occurrence: Verbal warning to the student with a written notice to parents.

- **Second Occurrence:** Suspension from participation in the selected activity for a one-day period.
- **Third Occurrence:** Suspension from participation in the activity for the remainder of the program.

As we want all children to benefit from our Winter Camp, we ask you to talk to your child and explain this policy and the consequences of not following Nido rules.

#### Pick-up Policy for Students Who Do Not Ride Winter Camp Buses

Winter Camp at Nido de Aguilas finishes at 13:00hrs. Students who ride home by car or other transportation services must be picked up at the Middle School Plaza. Please be advised that students should not wait for their parents in the parking lot area without adult supervision.
