



Nido Alumni Association Distinguished Alumni Award Criteria and Rules

The Distinguished Alumni Award is open to all Nido Alumni whether graduates of Nido or not. This award is given to an individual who exemplifies the Values of the International School Nido de Aguilas and has demonstrated outstanding leadership, creativity and service-- thus contributing to making his/her community, and the world, a better place.

The Award is given to a maximum of two individuals on an annual basis when applicable (it is not necessary for an individual to be selected every year)

Nominations

Nominations for the award will be accepted until June 1 each year. To nominate a candidate please submit a brief (500 words or less) summary describing:

- The project or program of the individual, explaining why it is innovative
- The impact of the program i.e. how it has contributed to the wellbeing of his/her community, society and/or the planet
- How the project, program or work of this individual can inspire current Nido students
- The name of the individual and his/her class

Selection Committee

A selection committee will be nominated annually by the President of the Alumni Association.

Recognition

The recipient that has been selected to receive the award will be presented with the award at the Annual Alumni Reunion. The recipient will be notified in October, and will be responsible for his/her own travel arrangements when necessary.

Confidentiality

Please do not inform candidates that they are under consideration since only a limited number of recipients are chosen each year from among many worthy individuals. All deliberations are kept confidential.
