The Alumni Scholarship Fund

A partnership between the Nido Alumni Association and Nido de Aguilas

The Alumni Scholarship Fund was established to support alumni who would like to send their children to Nido but cannot cover the full cost of a Nido education. The fund was founded by the Class of 1992, who made the very first donation to the project in memory of their classmate Julián Andrés Cárcamo Küllmer (1975-2004).

How does the scholarship work?

In 2016, Nido founded a financial aid program that is need-based, and, if awarded, is given as a discount on tuition and/or the incorporation fee. The Alumni Scholarship Fund is a special type of aid only available to the children of Nido alumni.

The 2018-19 school year is the first year in which the scholarships will be awarded. The funds

raised for the Alumni Scholarship are given each year. The total funds available are divided between all children of alumni who are determined eligible for aid through Nido's financial aid program. Families indicate that they are an alumni family during application for automatic consideration for the Scholarship. Students not currently at Nido must also apply for admissions through the Admissions Office at the same time. The family's financial situation is examined carefully to ensure that aid is distributed fairly. Aid is reviewed on an annual basis to determine whether the family's needs have changed. At this time, the Alumni Scholarship Program provides a portion of the financial aid package for alumni children. We hope that in the future, the Program can fully fund the irfinancial aid needs.

For the 2018-19 school year:

8 alumni children have been offered the scholarship

5 of these students were not previously at Nido

3 were already at Nido but their families were struggling to pay the fees

50 students have been offered general financial aid
